## The local audit regulatory system - system partners

There are six bodies in England with statutory responsibilities relating to local audit:

## The Financial Reporting Council (FRC) is

responsible for setting auditing standards in the UK, sets guidance for and supervises CIPFA and the ICAEW, and supervises audit firms and performs audit quality reviews of major local audits. The FRC has a non-statutory role as incoming shadow system leader in which it chairs and provides secretariat support to the Local Audit Liaison Committee. The National Audit Office (NAO) and **Comptroller and Auditor** General (C&AG) have responsibility for setting the Code of Audit Practice and issuing associated guidance. The NAO also undertake supporting activities like chairing the Local Auditors Advisory Group, technical networks and maintaining contracts for actuarial, valuation and legal support for local auditors.

## The **Chartered Institute** of **Public Finance and Accountancy (CIPFA)** is the recognised qualifying body for local audit. In addition to providing secretariat to the CIPFA Local Authority (Scotland) Accounts Advisory Committee (LASAAC) Board, which sets the Code of Practice on Local Authority Accounting,

CIPFA sets other Codes of Practice and provides good practice bulletins and other guidance to the sector.
